

God's Medicine

Proverbs 4:20-22 My son, give attention to my words; Incline your ear to my sayings. Do not let them depart from your eyes; Keep them in the midst of your heart; For they *are* life to those who find them, And health to all their flesh.

John 6:63 It is the Spirit who gives life; the flesh profits nothing. The words that I speak to you are spirit, and *they* are life.

Hebrews 11:6 ...He is a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him.

1 Peter 2:24 Who Himself bore our sins in His own body on the tree, that we, having died to sins, might live for righteousness—by whose stripes you were healed.

Galatians 3:13 Christ has redeemed us from the curse of the law, having become a curse for us (for it is written, “Cursed *is* everyone who hangs on a tree”).

Mark 11:23 “For assuredly, I say to you, whoever says to this mountain, ‘Be removed and be cast into the sea,’ and does not doubt in his heart, but believes that those things he says will be done, he will have whatever he says.”

Hebrews 10:23 Let us hold fast the confession of *our* hope without wavering, for He who promised *is* faithful.

Psalms 119:50 This *is* my comfort in my affliction, For Your word has given me life.

Psalms 30:2 O LORD my God, I cried out to You, And You healed me.

Romans 10:17 So then faith *comes* by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.

Exodus 15:26 “For I *am* the LORD who heals you.”

Jeremiah 30:17 ‘For I will restore health to you, And heal you of your wounds,’ says the LORD.

Romans 4:17-21 God, who gives life to the dead and calls those things which do not exist as though they did; Abraham who, contrary to hope, in hope believed,...And not being weak in faith, he did not consider his own body.... He did not waver at the promise of God through unbelief, but was strengthened in faith, giving glory to God, and being fully convinced that what He had promised He was also able to perform.

John 10:10 The thief does not come except to steal, and to kill, and to destroy. I have come that they may have life, and that they may have *it* more abundantly.

Luke 10:18,19 And He said to them, “I saw Satan fall like lightning from heaven. Behold, I give you the authority to trample on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy, and nothing shall by any means hurt you.”

Colossians 1:13 He has delivered us from the power of darkness and conveyed *us* into the kingdom of the Son of His love.

Acts 10:38 How God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and with power, who went about doing good and healing all who were oppressed by the devil, for God was with Him.

Galatians 5:1 Stand fast therefore in the liberty by which Christ has made us free, and do not be entangled again with a yoke of bondage.

Mark 10:27 But Jesus looked at them and said, “With men *it is* impossible, but not with God; for with God all things are possible.”

Mark 9:23 Jesus said to him, “If you can believe, all things *are* possible to him who believes.”

John 11:40 Jesus said to her, “Did I not say to you that if you would believe you would see the glory of God?”

Romans 8:11 But if the Spirit of Him who raised Jesus from the dead dwells in you, He who raised Christ from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies through His Spirit who dwells in you.

2 Corinthians 5:17 Therefore, if anyone *is* in Christ, *he is* a new creation; old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new.

2 Corinthians 10:4,5 For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal but mighty in God for pulling down strongholds, casting down imaginations and every high thing that exalts itself against the knowledge of God, bringing every thought into captivity to the obedience of Christ.

Ephesians 6:10-18 Be strong in the Lord and the power of His might. Put on the whole armor of God that you may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil...having done all, to stand. Stand therefore girded with truth, righteousness, peace, faith (to quench all the fiery darts), salvation, and the Word of God, praying always in the Spirit.

John 8:32 You shall know the truth and the truth shall set you free.

Psalm 107:20 He sent His word and healed them.

Ezekiel 36:36 I, the Lord, have spoken it, and I will do it.

Joshua 21:45 Not a word failed of any good thing which the LORD had spoken to the house of Israel. All came to pass.

Matthew 4:4 But He answered and said, “It is written, ‘Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that proceeds from the mouth of God.’”

Hebrews 4:12 For the word of God is living and powerful and sharper than any two-edged sword...

Exodus 23:25 “So you shall serve the LORD your God, and He will bless your bread and your water. And I will take sickness away from the midst of you.”

Isaiah 53:4-5 Surely He has borne our griefs, And carried our sorrows; Yet we esteemed Him stricken, Smitten by God, and afflicted. But He *was* wounded for our transgressions, *He was* bruised for our iniquities; The chastisement for our peace *was* upon Him, And by His stripes we are healed.

Jeremiah 33:6 ‘Behold, I will bring it health and healing; I will heal them and reveal to them the abundance of peace and truth.’

Luke 1:37 “For no word from God will ever fail.”

Deuteronomy 7:15 And the Lord will take away from you all sickness. .

2 Corinthians 2:14 Now thanks be to God who always leads us in triumph in Christ.

1 Corinthians 2:4,5 And my speech and my preaching *were* not with persuasive words of human wisdom, but in demonstration of the Spirit and of power, that your faith should not be in the wisdom of men but in the power of God.

Psalm 103:2,3 Bless the Lord, O my soul, And forget not all His benefits: Who forgives all your sins, Who heals all your diseases.

Jeremiah 17:14 Heal me O Lord, and I shall be healed; Save me, and I shall be saved. For You are my praise.

Malachi 4:2 But to you who fear My name The Sun of Righteousness shall arise with healing in His wings.

Psalm 34:19 Many are the afflictions of the righteous; But the Lord delivers him out of them all.

Zechariah 4:6 Not by might, nor by power, but by My Spirit says the Lord of hosts.

2 Kings 20:5 I have heard your prayer, I have seen your tears; surely I will heal you.

Psalms 41:3 The Lord sustains him on his sickbed; in his illness You restore him to full health.

Isaiah 54:17 No weapon formed against you shall prosper.

John 8:44 When he lies, he speaks what is natural to him, for he is a liar and the father of lies.

1 John 3:8 For this purpose the Son of God was manifested, that He might destroy the works of the devil.

Deuteronomy 8:3 He humbled you, causing you to hunger and then feeding you with manna, which neither you nor your ancestors had known, to teach you that man does not live on bread alone but on every word that comes from the mouth of the LORD.

Hebrews 6:12 ...imitate those who are receiving the promises through faith and patience.

Isaiah 46:11 Indeed, I have spoken it; I will also bring it to pass. I have purposed it; I will also do it.

Isaiah 58:8 Then your light shall break forth like the morning, your healing shall spring forth speedily. And your righteousness shall go before you. The glory of the Lord shall be your rearguard.

Isaiah 55: 8, 9 “For My thoughts are not your thoughts, nor are your ways My ways,” says the Lord. “For as the heavens are higher than the earth, so are My ways higher than your ways. And My thoughts than your thoughts.”

Psalms 91:14 Because he has set his love upon Me, therefore I will deliver him.

Ezekiel 12:25 For I am the Lord. I speak and the word which I speak will come to pass; it will no more be postponed. I say the word and perform it, says the Lord God.

Matthew 8:17 ...that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by Isaiah the prophet, saying: “He Himself took our infirmities and bore our sicknesses.”

2 Corinthians 5:7 For we walk by faith, not by sight.

Mark 11:24 “Therefore I say to you, whatever things you ask when you pray, believe that you have received them, and you will have them.”

Ezekiel 17:24 “I, the Lord, have spoken and have done it.”

James 4:7 Resist the devil and he will flee from you.

Jeremiah 1:12 “I watch over My word to perform it.”

Isaiah 55:10,11 “For as the rain comes down, and the snow from heaven, And do not return there, But water the earth, And make it bring forth and bud, That it may give seed to the sower And bread to the eater, So shall My word be that goes forth from My mouth; It shall not return to Me void, But it shall accomplish what I please, And it shall prosper in the thing for which I sent it.”

Isaiah 30:15 In returning and rest, you shall be healed. In quietness and confidence (trust) shall be your strength.

Exodus 33:14 “My Presence will go with you, and I will give you rest.”

Psalms 91:1 He who dwells in the secret place of the Most High shall rest under the shadow of the Almighty.

Matthew 11:28 “Come to Me, all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest.”

Joshua 1:8 “This Book of the Law shall not depart from your mouth, but you shall meditate in it day and night, that you may observe to do according to all that is written in it. For then you will make your way prosperous, and then you will have good success.”

1 John 5:14-15 This is the confidence that we have in Him, that if we ask anything according to His will, He hears us. And if we know that He hears us, whatever we ask, we know that we have the petitions that we have asked of Him.

Psalms 89:34 My covenant I will not break, nor alter the word that has gone out of My lips.

1 Corinthians 15:57 But thanks be to God who gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ.

Revelations 21:1&8 For the former things have passed away...Behold I make all things new.

Deuteronomy 31:8 And the Lord, He is the One who goes before you. He will not leave you nor forsake you; do not fear nor be dismayed.

Deuteronomy 30:14 The word is very near you, in your mouth and in your heart, that you may do it.

Acts 19:20 So the word of the Lord grew mightily and prevailed.
